Young Environment Journalist Award (Print, Electronic & Online)

These biennial awards are a countrywide recognition of journalists (21-35 years of age) who have made a significant contribution in either the print, electronic and online media to an understanding of the nation's environmental problems.

- The awards are open to Indian Journalists from print, electronic and online media (national as well as regional and freelance journalists).
- There are four awards. Two awards in print and one each in electronic and online media.
- The applicants would be required to submit their work i.e. published/ broadcast stories (not more than 3 stories, i.e. print's scanned copy/e-news or news video or series) along with their application.
- The award comprises of a trophy, citation and prize money of Rs 25,000/- each.

- The awards will be presented during the Award ceremony of 11th Competitive Edition of CMS VATAVARAN
