# *City students' films make it to Delhi fest*

**Oct. 25:** Three animated films made by city students have been nominated for International Wildlife and Environmental Film Festival to be held in New Delhi from October 27 to October 31st.

The films *Fuel Duel*, *Farmer and his Goat* and *A Garden Dream* made by some local students of Dilshuknagar are to be screened at the festival.

In all, 106 films will be screened in the CMS vatavaran festival at the India Habitat Centre from across the world. Nine films from South India, including three from AP, bagged nomination for the festival.

*A Garden Dream* is a short film made by Aarthi, Nilesh and Tushar highlighting the

importance of cleanliness among kids

Bhuvan, a student who made *Fuel Duel*, said, "Man has been using up fuel at such an alarming rate that we could soon run out of gas on planet earth. *Fuel Duel* is an animated short film that brings up the ongoing clash of interests between the various fuel sources available to mankind and even suggests a humorous return to natural vehicles as a means of extending our existence on earth."

The film was made by him along with Arush, Arun and Jagdish. *The Farmer and his Goat* is an attempt to discourage the practice of animal sacrifice.
