A special highlight of the day was a masterclass conducted by Ms Caroline Libresco, a creative producer and former director of Sundance Women's Initiative, who served as a head programmer at the Sundance Film Festival for 18 years. Her session on "Finding Your Pitch...and Your Film" was well-received by over 200 film students, sparking insightful conversations about storytelling and the art of filmmaking.

Panel Discussion:

Another key event was the panel discussion on 'Inspiring Stories for a Sustainable Future,' moderated by Prof. Sanjeev Sood, filmmaker and professor at Sharda University. The panel featured distinguished participants, including Dr. Nimish Kapoor (Scientist 'E' & Head, Science Films Division), Ms. Shivani Pandey (award-winning photojournalist, writer, filmmaker, and blogger), Ms. Hem Saroya (news anchor at WION), and Mr. Sabyasachi Bharti (Deputy Director, CMS VATAVARAN). The discussion explored how inspiring storytelling can drive awareness and action for a more sustainable world.

The day concluded with participants reaffirming their commitment to eco-friendly practices and wetland conservation in their communities. The event at Sharda University was a resounding success, furthering CMS VATAVARAN's mission to inspire a global movement for a sustainable future.
